Thanks Tom, 18 year old Jennifer Hayes' parent's were thrilled when the detective they had hired had finally managed to track down their daughter after two long years. Unfortunately before they could make contact with their daughter she has gone missing again, this time, feared kidnapped.

Jennifer Hayes ran away from home at 16 years old when she found out she was pregnant and her parents forbid her an abortion. A decision they say they have regretted ever since.

However when police efforts proved inadequate to find the girl the family hired a private detective firm, Jones and Walsh to track down the girl. It took them two long years but they found her, selling herself for money to outside of a truck stop in Smyrna. However before they could tell the Hayes', Jennifer disappeared again.

Witnesses declined to be interviewed on camera but report seeing her enter a dark colored GTO cruiser with two men. The vehicle had Alabama plates and the two men were flashing around a lot of cash. The two men were not caught on camera but police were able to compile a sketch from eye witness accounts. If you have any information about Jennifer or the two men please report it to the police immediately. The family is offering a \$5000 reward for information leading to Jennifer.
